3 and 4 Year old Nursery Places – Chargeable extras

From January 2026 Early Education Providers are required to publish the costs of any chargeable extras in line with the Department for Education's Statutory Guidance. Costs should be clear, up-to-date and easily accessible to parents, to enable parents to make an informed choice of provider.

Below is the outline of what is provided for 3 and 4-year-old Nursery children attending St Mark's C of E Primary School.

| <p>Snacks of fruit, vegetables, milk and water available throughout each session.</p> <p>A fresh fruit or vegetable snack (which can consist of banana, orange, apple, carrots) is provided by school as part of the Governments Fruit & Veg Scheme for Schools.</p> <p>The fruit and vegetables will be fresh and of good quality. The aim is for children to have a positive and enjoyable experience of fruit and vegetables.</p> <p>Each child is entitled to receive 189ml (1/3 pint) of milk each day, free of charge. This is ordered by the school for all pupils eligible.</p> <p>The Nursery Milk Scheme is operated by the Nursery Milk Reimbursement Unit (NMRU) on behalf of the Department of Health and Social Care and Welsh Government. It entitles children under 5 years who attend approved day care facilities to receive 189ml (1/3 pint) of milk each day, free of charge.</p> | Per snack and drink | Free | Free |
