Through our provision, we will be exploring a variety of mini beasts, flowers, leaves, fruits and vegetables in lots of different ways.



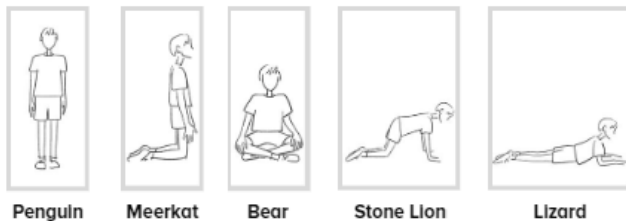
We love playing with water in Nursery and throughout the summer, we will be experimenting with how we can move water from one container to another using pipes and guttering.

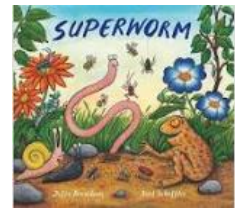
We support our children to become writers in the following ways:

- Fine motor activities to build hand-eye co-ordination and finger strength. These are things such as using tweezers, picking up small objects such as rice, threading, colouring, cutting and playing with play-dough.
- Learn the correct kinetic letter positions to help us build strength in the muscles we will need when writing.
- Encouraging our children to use a tripod grip rather than a whole fist grip when they mark making.
- Encouraging children to give meanings to the mark's they make.
