

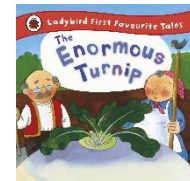
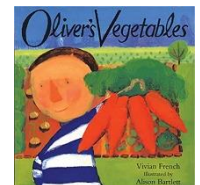
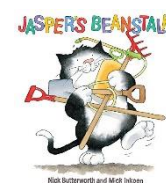
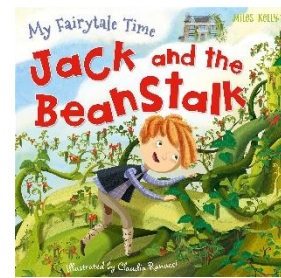
RECEPTION LEARNING OVERVIEW

BOOKS

In English, we will be reading:



One very important aspect of learning throughout school is reading and therefore early reading is critical for a child's development. We would very much appreciate if you could continue to read with your child/children daily to support their learning.

Please make sure you have commented or signed in your child's diary so we know that the book has been read and we can change books on a regular basis. We change books every **Tuesday** and **Friday**.

There are some words which are tricky words which we cannot sound out. We teach the children to look, recognise and say these words. So far, the tricky words we have learnt so far are: **I, the, no, to, go** and **into, be, we, he, she, me, was, you**

As a reminder, the children are able to access the Floppy's Phonics books online at home through the Oxford Owl website. Once on the Floppy's Phonics page you will be able to log in using **receptionsmcoe**. This is both the username and password.

As you may have noticed, the children come home with two phonics sheets per week. These are the new sounds taught in phonics lessons and provide the opportunity for your child to share their new learning with you. This will also help you to know the correct level of eBooks to access online.

MATHEMATICS

During maths lessons this half term, we will be focusing on numerical pattern. The children will practise and build upon their mathematical language, including key vocabulary and using a variety of resources to support their knowledge and understanding. Children will be looking at doubling, halving and sharing. They will continue to consolidate their knowledge of number to 10 by exploring more than and less than. In fluency, we will practise building on our knowledge of number bonds to 10 until we can automatically recall the number bonds.

TOPIC

The topic that we will be studying is **PLANTING AND GROWING**. Whilst we will be completing all curriculum subjects, this topic covers all 7 areas of Early Years curriculum. We will be learning:

- Life cycles of animals and plants
- Parts of a plants and what they need to grow
- Naming animals and their young – looking at how some animals are born and some are hatched
