## BOOKS

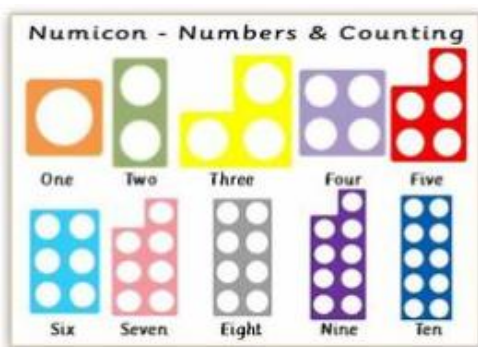
We love reading in Nursery and this half term our core texts will be:

We will learn a new Nursery Rhyme each week and will share this with you on Class Dojo. From 17<sup>th</sup> September, you will be invited to come into school every Wednesday at 11:20 to join us when we listen to a story and sing some Nursery Rhymes. The Library trolley will be out afterwards and your child can choose a book to take home for the week. They can then change this the following Wednesday.

## MATHEMATICS



This half term we will be introducing the children to Numicon. We will begin by all exploring Numicon together and we will be talking about the different shapes, colours and numbers that the pieces represent.

## Independence

We will continue to encourage the children to become more independent. This will include things such as putting their coat and shoes on by themselves and having a go at doing their own zip. We will also be trying hard to remember which are our belongings and being able to fetch them by ourselves. For some children we will work on their confidence with communication, talking to their friends and to familiar adults.
