## MFL French: Cycle B AutumnTerm

### UKS2

**Unit Focus: Ma ville, La France**

**Rationale:** Children must build on their knowledge French basics and descriptive language. They can also develop their understanding of masculine, feminine and plural nouns and adjectival agreement.

The children have struggled to write a greater length in sentences, so they are being given the opportunity to develop from single word retrieval to full sentences and paragraphs (for Year 6).

- listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding
  - engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others; seek clarification and help
  - speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
  - develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand when they are reading aloud or using familiar words and phrases\*
  - present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences
  - read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing
  - broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary
  - write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly
  - describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing
  - understand basic grammar appropriate to the language being studied
